- This project was a reconstruction of the event management android app for YWCA of Bombay previously built by DBIT SevaTech.
- The YWCA is an International Movement that unites 25 million women from over 100 countries, having a vision of a fully inclusive world where justice, peace, health, human dignity, freedom and care for the environment are achieved through women's leadership.
- The project began in November 2020, when the ex-chairpersons of DBIT SevaTech onboarded the team.
- The team was led by Ruvin and Shawn by coordinating with officials from YWCA of Bombay.
- This project was started from scratch by creating a prototype, which was designed by Priyal and Anish using Figma, in December.
- The app was developed using Flutter framework, keeping in mind the future scope of making the app cross-platform.
- Google's Firebase was used as the cloud database and user authentication service through the user's mobile number.
- All members contributed equally to the development of the user interface of the app.
- The codebase was managed by Shawn using Git.
- The backend of the app was developed by Ruvin and Lav.
- The app was completed in October 2021 and published on Google Playstore.
